STC.172-14 BUDGET 2015/2016

The Acting Town Clerk made a presentation to members which included the background on the budget, why councils prepare budgets, how the budget is prepared, how councils determine their precept, how to calculate a councils tax base, the format of Stanley Town Council's budget and the current position.

Members looked at each section in details – staffing, democracy, office accommodation, administration, publicity, projects & initiatives, events, civic hall, services and planning.

It was **RESOLVED** that the budget for Environmental Enhancement (£15,000) be amalgamated with the new Environmental Services budget, making a provision of £179,730.

It was also **RESOLVED** that Stanley Town Council will contact DCC and Groundworks to inform them that contracts for Neighbourhood Wardens and Community Environmental Caretakers will come to an end on 31 March 2015.
